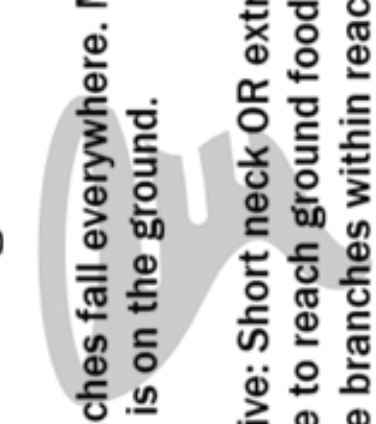
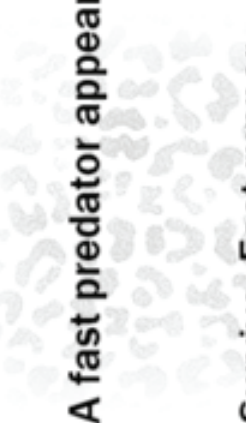
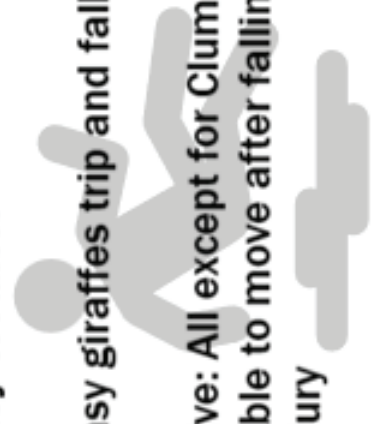
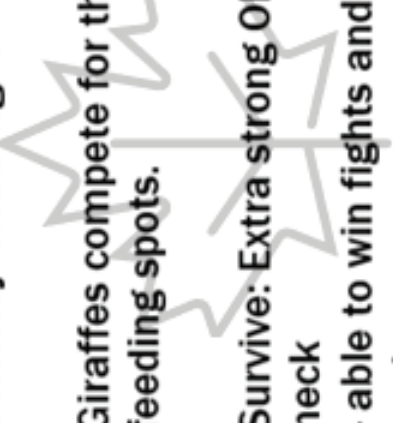


Drought Season: Only high leaves remain on the trees. Survive: Long neck - able to reach the leaves 	Storm Damage: Branches fall everywhere. Most food is on the ground. Survive: Short neck OR extra strong - able to reach ground food or move branches within reach. 	Tree Growth Burst: Trees grow taller this year. Survive: Long neck - able to reach the higher branches 
Predator Night Feeding: Unable to see predators that are hunting at night. Survive: Camouflage pattern - predators unable to see them 	Predator Ambush: Lions hide in tall grass waiting to ambush. Survive: Long neck OR fast runner - able to see lions hiding or escape quickly 	Cheetah Chase: A fast predator appears. Survive: Fast runner - able to quickly escape 
Rough Terrain: Rough terrain makes movement difficult. Survive: All except for Injured - unable to travel through rough terrain 	Clumsy Trouble: Clumsy giraffes trip and fall. Survive: All except for Clumsy - unable to move after falling due to injury 	Territory Challenge: Giraffes compete for the best feeding spots. Survive: Extra strong OR long neck - able to win fights and defend territory 

Bitter Leaf Season:

Trees produce bitter-tasting leaves this year. Only high branches contain quality leaves.

Survive: Long neck OR extra strong
- able to withstand poor taste or reach higher branches

Food Poisoning Season:

Some leaves become contaminated with toxins and bacteria.

Survive: Disease resistant OR extra strong
- able to consume leaves without becoming ill or able to recover from illness

Silent Stalker:

A predator hunts by sight.

Survive: Camouflage pattern
- able to remain undetected

Leaf Fungus Outbreak:

A fungus infects many trees.

Survive: Disease resistant
- able to consume infected leaves without becoming sick

Parasite Swarm:

Parasites target weak individuals.

Survive: Extra strong OR disease resistant
- able to prevent or withstand infection

Waterhole Infection:

Bacteria spreads through a shared water source.

Survive: Disease-resistant
- able to prevent infection

Heatwave Stress:

A record heatwave hits. Only the healthiest individuals cope.

Survive: Extra strong

Mating Battles:

Males fight using their necks.

Survive: Long neck OR extra strong
- able to win the fight

Speed Mating Season:

Females choose the fastest males to mate with.

Survive: Fast runner
- able to be chosen by the female

Group Defense:

The herd must move quickly to escape danger.

Survive: Fast runner

- able to outpace the predators

Social Camouflage:

Predators avoid large herds that blend in.

Survive: Camouflage pattern OR

long neck
- able to blend in or spot predators from a distance

Thorny Season:

A drought causes acacia trees to grow extra-sharp thorns.

Survive: Extra strong

Dry River Crossing:

A seasonal river has dried up leaving behind deep cracks and uneven ground.

Survive: All except Clumsy or Injured
- unable to cross terrain

Muddy Migration:

Heavy rainfall turns the ground into a mud pit.

Survive: Extra strong

Low Shrub Habitat:

Tall trees die off. Low shrubs are the primary foliage.

Survive: Short neck
- able to reach lower plants

Dense Brush:

Predators hunt in thick, low brush.

Survive: Short neck

- able to stay hidden

Flooded Grasslands:

Heavy seasonal rains flood low-lying plants.

Survive: Long necks

- able to reach taller plants

Dusty Ground Conditions:

A long dry season creates a dusty, sandy ground. Low leaves are covered in dust, causing mouth irritation when ingested.

Survive: Long neck

- able to reach unaffected leaves
